

FLAMEROBINhasabrightorange breastandthroat, withawhitelower bellyandundertail. The backandtop of the head is dark grey. The female is mostly grey - brown with a pale - buff wingstripe. Flame Robins live up to about 1800 mabove sealevel, and in winter, they move to lower and more open areas. We often see the msitting on stumps or fences and often at the tops of our hills.
