### THE HIGHLANDS MAILBOX

The old mailbox at the end
(beginning?) of Lade's Road was built
by Doug's father in the early 1900s.
This was when he and his brother
Percy came home from school to
Highlands to their bush block of
bracken and wattle scrub.
Their father, Henry, was among the first
settlers in Highlands in 1882, but he
had died as a young man.



When I came to Highlands at the beginning of 1951, the mailman was Vin Hall from Seymour. He would bring groceries, bread etc. with the mail.

All you had to do was ring the Seymour Post Office and say "Has Vin left yet? If not, please ask him to bring an extra loaf of bread". Often, visitors or residents could get a lift back to Seymour with him to catch the train. How sad we all were when he retired!

The mailbox was shared with MacAlpins, Yorstons, and Henshaws. At some stage we got a female mail person and she said to me "Why don't you get the mail delivered to your front gate?"

So we all signed a petition and now we have it, and 'newish' mail-boxes.
