IntheleafletHelenpreparedforthe OpenGardenSchemerecently,she notedthattherehadbeensome lossesduringthedrought,butsheis hopingthatmanyoftheplantsthat shesubjectedtosome'seriouspruning'withachainsawwillrevive.After all,thisgardenhassurvivedmanya toughsummer,stormsandwindsinits time.

Thegardenmayhavebeenalittle shortonflowersthisyear, but now the treestakingontheirautumncolours showlittlesignofthestressesandthe recentrainshaverevivedthemany groundcoverslefttostruggleonby themselvesduringthedrytimes. Allaroundthehouseandinthelarge fernery, Helenhaskeptherpotplants withgreywater, and with much delight Inoticedthatshehadalsomade manyofthepots. Myfavouritewas the separatorbowlpaintedgreen, and decoratedwithadesignofnasturtiums ontheside.AsHelensaysinher notes,"Youwillseethatthisisasimplegardenthathasgrownalittleata timemostdefinitelynotadesigner's job."
