Gearing up for a climatic election at the McEwen electorate Candidate Forum

Thenightwasclearandalittlechilly asaround75localcommunitymembersgatheredattheYeaShireHallin anticipationfortheirlocalmember's responsetothepressingissueofclimatechange. Theeveningpromised tobeaninterestingandenlightening event, asitisseldomthatthelocal communitygetstheopportunityto comparealltheirFederalCandidates' politicalandpersonalviewpointson theissueofclimatechangeandwhat canbedonetoreducetheimpending problemswhichitencompasses.

Theeveningwasopenedandchaired byBobFlowers,MayorofMurrindindi. ThefourFederalCandidatesforMcE-wenwhocametospeakincluded RobertMitchell,theLaborPartycandidate,SteveMeacher,theGreenscandidate,FranBailey,theLiberalcandidateandDavidScottKane,theDemocratscandidate.

Theguestspeakerforthenight, Tricia PhelanfromEnvironmentVictoria, gaveanengagingandinformative presentationonclimatechange.The talkset -the-scenepresentingthelatestscientificfindingsreleasedearlier thisyearbytheInternationalPanelon ClimateChange,includingtheimpact ofhumanproducedgreenhousegas emissionsonsea -levelrise, arctic sea-icemeltandnaturaldisasters, including the ever present and potentiallypermanentdryingofouralready parchedcontinent.Triciaalsoprovidedprinciplesandtargetstoreducinggreenhouseemissions.Lookup TheBigSwitchwebsite www.thebigswitch.org.aufordetails.

Itwasthenthecandidatesturnto showwhattheirpartiesweregoingto dototackleclimatechange. Three questionsweregiventothecandidatesinadvanceoftheforumtoensuretheywereabletogettheirparties messageacross. Thethreequestions were; (1) Willyourpartysignthe Kyoto Protocol? Please explainyour reasoning, (2) Pleasestateclearly yourpartiesaimemissionstargets and yourimmediate plantoachievethese. and (3) Whatisthegreatestopportunity for the McEwenelectorateina carboneconomy?

Therewasanoverwhelmingagreementthatclimatechangeisapressing issueandthatimmediatestepsneed tobetakentotackleclimatechange. However,therewereverydifferent viewpointsonhowthiscouldbe achieved.TheLiberalcandidate,Fran Bailey,wastheonlyspeakertosaythat herpartywouldnotratifytheKyotoprotocol,asitdidnotcoverdeveloping countriessuchasChinaandIndia,but thatotherforumssuchastheAsia - PacificPartnershipwouldprovidethe opportunitytodefineanemissionreductionpath.However,theLiberalparty couldnotbedrawntosaywhatitsexact targetswouldbetoreducegreenhouse emissions.

Incontrast, the other candidates all confirmedthattheirpartieswouldratify Kyotoinordertoadhereatoncetobindinggreenhouseemissiontargetsfor developednationsandtomoveforwardstogetherwiththedevelopingnationsinaPost -Kyotoagreement. WhereastheLaborpartyaimsata60% reductionof2000levelsby2050,the Greenssaidtheywouldreducegreenhousegasemissionsby30%of1990 levelsby2020andby80%of1990levelsby2050.Withrespecttoalternatives toafossilfuelbasedenergyproduction, theDemocratssaidthattheywouldaim atamandatoryrenewableenergytarget of25%by2020and50%by2050. Similarly, forthe Greensrenewableenergyshouldalsobepromotedbymeans ofamandatoryrenewableenergytarget startingwith15%by2012and25%by 2020, withafeed -intariffsystemand regulationsprovidingastrongincentive toswitchtorenewables.

Onthelastquestion, all candidates agreed that the McEwen Electorate could play a major role in a carbon economy through green initiatives and via schemes such as tree - planting and renewable energy technologies such as soler.
