Interestinlandscapehistoryledtotravel inEurope, Nepal, USA, and workinGermanyinlandscapearchitectureandconstructionforabout2years.Thiswasa challengingbutenrichingtimeoflearning anewlanguageandculture, experiencing awholenewlandscapeofspaceand plants.
