DickandhiswifeMollyheldHabbies untilhisdeathin1978.Mollyhadstarted therestorationofthehomesteadand garden. The property was subdivided intoGlenlyon(heldbyBrianLeahy's family),Kobyboyn(heldbyBill tion-Webbandhisfamily)andHabbies Howe, which was bought by Henry and AnitaSymonsofKoalashoesfame. Theydidwonderfulthingstothehouse andgarden. Eachandeveryformer ownerhaslefttheirmarkonHabbies whetheritwastheStewart -builtIndian Bungalowhomestead, the halcyondays spanningtheperiodofboththeWebbs involvement(whentheaimwasa1000 cowsandathousandbalesofwool)or therestorationworkofthegardenand housebytheSymons.HHwentinto terminaldeclinewhenboughtbyabrokendowncockyfromNSWin1998.



BLACKWATTLE - Acaciamearnsii.

BlackWattle, with its paleyellow flowers, is flowering now. (not to be confused with the early Spring flowering Silver Wattle). Black Wattle is fast growing, drought to lerant, and has a larger ange of food and habit at values to a variety of wild life. Crevices in the bark are home to many in sects and invertebrates. Yellow Tailed Black Cockatoos striptheouter bark when searching for Longicorn be et les and Wattle Goat moth larvae. Thorn bills and Honeyeaters gorge onde foliating in sects, the pollen from the flowers and nectar in the leaf axils.
