TWININGGLYCINE -(Glycineclandestina) -isaslenderclimberwith palebluish -mauvepeaflowers, and is reasonablycommoninourbush areasandalongsomelocalroadsides, if they are not grazed. It flowers in the spring, but seeds can still be collected in February, and it can be grown in containers and gardens. It is very hardy, once established, and the flowers are agood nectar source for native in sects.

Perameles nasuta.

Theseomnivorousmarsupialswere oncecommoninthelocalareaand theHighlandsLandcareGrouphas receivedfundingtoinvestigatetheir remainingpopulations.

Thelong -nosedbandicootsaregrey -brownincolourwithacreamy -white underside. They are about the size of a larger abbit and are nocturnal. They inhabit dampare as along creeks or aroundswamps and bogs where there is dense under growth in which tone standes cape from predators, especially foxes and wild cats.

Itismostoftenthesmall,conical holes(6 -10cm.across),whichthey digwhileforagingforfood,thatindicatetheirpresence.


