AfteraperiodoftimeDPlofficerswill revisitthepropertiesandseewhat progresshasbeenmadeacrossthe district.

Theaimoftheprogramistogetall thecommunitycommittedandworkingontheirblackberryatthesame time. Wheneveryoneisworkingon theirweedsatthesametimethereis amuchgreaterchanceofreducing theimpactoftheblackberryonnot onlyyourownproperty, butalsoyour directneighbours, nottomention Ol' Georgesplace5 milesthataway.

Theseprogramsalsoinvolvethepubliclandmanagers, suchas Local Government, the Department of Sustainability and Environment, Vic Roads, and Parks Vic, so that the fight against black berry is coming from all sides.




