OneinfiveAustralianswillexperience amentalillness.Episodesofmental illnesscancomeandgothroughouta person'slife.Somepeopleexperience theirmentalillnessonlyonceandthen fullyrecover.Onlyabouthalfofthose affectedbymentalillnessreceive treatment.

"Mentalillness" referstoagroupof illnessesthataffectthebrain. Mental illnessescanbeseparated into two maincategories:

Depressionandanxietydisordersare themostcommon —forexample,persistentfeelingsofdepression,sadness,tensionorfearthataresodisturbingtheyaffecttheperson'sability tocopewithday -to-dayactivities. This categoryalsoincludesphobias, obsessive compulsive disorder, and eating disorders.

Psychoticillness –lesscommonbut moresevere –includesschizophrenia andbipolardisorder(previouslycalled manicdepressiveillness). Psychosis affectsthebrainandcauseschanges inaperson'sthinking, emotions and behaviour. Peoplewhoexperiencean acutepsychoticepisodelosecontact with reality and may develop delusions and/or hall ucinations.

Somepeopleareaffectedbymore thanonecondition. The causes of mentalillness are often unclear — the recan be many different trigger factors, including stress, drugmisuse, and hormone changes. Provided they receive appropriate ongoing support and treatment, most people with mentalillness recover well and are able to lead fulfilling lives in the community.


