MAVISandDONCOOKofRuffy,live onanidyllic2kmsectionofHughes creek,whereplatypusesareregularly seen.MavisandDontreasurethe creek,whichtheyhavecompletely fencedoff,andtheydon'tbelievein takinganywaterfromit.Theyhave plantedhundredsofnativetrees.Don andMavis,andotherneighbours,care forthenearbyBoathole,removing willowsandcleaninguprubbishleftby thoughtlessvisitors.

Theyhaveasmallvineyard, with the intentionofasupplyofSauvignon Blancforthemselvesandfriends. MaviswasbroughtupinLiverpool, England, and in 1967, she arrived in Australiawith2smallchildrentostart anewlifeonherown, Shewasan experiencedbookkeeper,sosoon foundajob -infact,atfirstshetook on3jobs.Thenshemetafriendof herbrother, Don, who was stationed atSingleton, NSW, in the Army, and theymarriedin1972.AfterDonleft theArmy,hebecameSalesManager forCastrolOil.ThevlivedatPortFairv inan1858cottagemadeofrubble andfacedwithmud, which they restored. The next years saw the mliving inmanydifferentplaces,following Don'spromotionsandsubsequent movesinterstate.Infact,theylivedin 21housesin36years!WhenBPtook overCastrol,Donstartedhisown business, recruiting to pexecutives for variouscompanies.

However,theyyearnedforcountry living,and2yearslater,theydiscoveredtheRuffyproperty,followingan agent'sdirections.Afterguiltilyclimbingoverthelockedgatetoinspect, whoshouldtheymeetbuttheowners, whohappenedtobeverywell -known tothem!Asalewasspeedilyresolved toeveryone'ssatisfaction.Atfirst,Don travelledbackandforthtoMelbourne forhisjob,butnowworksinSheppartonfortheSalvationArmyasabusinessliaisonofficer,findingjobsfor long-termunemployed.

DonandMavishavebothinvolved themselvesintheRuffycommunity, DonisTreasureroftheHallCommittee,andworkingforacquisitionofthe oldRuffySchool,alsotheCFA. Mavisisanothermuchlovedand valuedvolunteerattheHighlands School,shesaysshe'dliketoadopt allthekids!


