The centre piece of the parkisanAustralianmadesculpture ofaLightHorsemanleapingthe trenches.Itmarksthechargeofthe 4thand12thL.H.Regimentsagainst TurkishpostsatBe'ershevaon 31/10/17andwasdedicatedbythe GovernorGeneral, Michael Jeffrey, theIsraeliPresidentandtheTurkish ForeignMinister.

Thebronzesculptureandrestoration oftheParkwasfundedbythePratt Foundation, and members of the familywerepresent.Aninterestinglocal connectionwasfindingthegraveofLt ColMaygarV.C.attheBe'ersheva cemetery. The Maygarfamily were originalownersof"Strathearn",Ruffy.

AnzacDavinJerusalemwasaspecialandmovingdayforDoug,asthey attendedtheDawnServiceatthe CommonwealthWarGravesCemetery,andlaterwenttoHerod'sfortress atMasada. AnotherhighlightwasdrivingalongtheshoreoftheDeadSea, wherehehadbeen66yearsago. In1938and'39, Dougbelongedto theYeaLightHorseTroop, -theyrode theirhorsesintoYeafortrainingand attendedcampsatTorquayand Broadmeadows.Whentheyrealized thatnohorseswouldbegoingtothe MiddleEast,theytooktheirhorses homeandenlistedinotherunits, Dougin9thDivCavRegiment.He trainedinSyria,servedinEgyptatEl Alamein, before returning to Australia andBorneointhewaragainstJapan. Thistripwasawonderfulexperience andalltheveteransareextremely gratefultotheDeptofVetAffairs.

Synopsis

The Victorian Governmenthas planned to resolve the state's water shortage by embarking on 2 major water projects, The Surf Coast Desalination Plant costing \$4.9 billion and The North South Pipeline costing \$1.3 billion

Thereissubstantialprotestfrom manysectorsofthecommunityabout bothoftheseprojectshoweveruntil nowaviablealternativehasnotbeen forthcomingtoresolvethewater shortageofthestate.

ASR(AquiferStorage&Recovery)is theprocessofdivertingthestorm waterfromthedrainsandchannels aroundMelbourneandstoringthemin theaquiferslocatedbelowMelbourne. Oncestored,peoplecandrawfrom theaquifersasasourceofsecond gradewaterforgeneralusethereby freeingupthestate'sfullypurified water.
