"Don't expect the price of chemicals to fall soon."

That's the latest message coming from the manufacturers. To add to the woes, the rear euroconfirmed reports that an umber of agchemmanufacturing factories have been caught up in the tragicearth quake in China. This will mean a further tightening in supply until at least September.

Inthelastfewweekstherehadbeen animprovementinthesupplyofgly-phosateproductswiththeexceptionof RoundupPowermax.Someofthe genericmanufacturershadbeenable tobring360and450strengthproduct intothecountry.Unfortunatelythe pricecontinuestorisewitheachdelivery.

Withthegoodrainsacrossthestate overtheweekendtherehasbeena spikeindemandforknockdown chemicals. Fortunately, afteradelayof severalweeksfordelivery, Wales Ruralnowhavegoodstocksofglyphosateacrosstherange, including Roundup Powermax. Other knockdownsare also ingoodsupply.

Worlddemandisdrivingupchemical andfertiliserprices.Demandisalso drivingupthecostoffood.According toa2006studybytheFood&AgricultureOrganisationandtheWorldBank, inthelast40yearstheworldpopulationhasdoubledandtheamountof agriculturallandavailableperheadof populationisdownbytwothirds. The frontpageofTheAgeonApril15carriedastoryabouttheWorldFoodCrisisexplainingthat100millionpeople arebeingpusheddeeperintopoverty duetotheriseinthecostofstaples: wheatup120%inayear,riceup75% intwomonths.

Accordingtothereport, at least part of the problem is the diversion of grains into biofuels -240 kgo f cornise nough to feed on eperson for a year or produce 100 lto ffuel.

Worldleadershaverespondedwith fundingfortheWorldFoodProgram butthisisnotsomethingthatisgoing tobesolvedovernight.Thedualdemandsforfoodandforalternativefuel sourcesaregoingtocontinuetoplace highstressontheagriculturalindustry toproducemore -evenasavailable agriculturallandshrinks.
