Theobjectiveofthisistoprotectsignificantspeciesandhabitatsfromthe adverseimpactsofDefenceactivities andmanageallotherthreatening processes.Thetargettoachieveisno adverseimpactsandnonetlossin indigenousspeciesorareasofvegetation

Armouredvehiclesrequireopencountryformanyoftheirtrainingactivities andtheJointProofandExperimental Unit(JPEU),Graytown,requiresopen areastoaccuratelyassesstheeffects ofammunitiontestsandavoidthe spreadoffire.Clearedareashave thereforebeenretainedatthesite, whileothershavebeenrevegetated.

Althoughthisretentionofclearedareasmayseeminconsistentwithconservation, it is likely to be an important factorintheincreasesinpopulations ofthreatenedspeciessuchasBush Stone-curlewandFat -tailedDunnart (Sminthopsiscrassicaudata). However, some of the seopenare as specificallyRangeEast,andpartsof RangeWestandJPEU,Graytown aremaintained predominantly as areasofintroducedgrasslandwith smallerareasofwoodland. Thisis becausenativegrasseshavenotbeen foundtoprovidetheamountofcover andresiliencerequiredtocushionthe manoeuvresoftanks. Elsewherein thewoodlandsandforests,tree,shrub andunderstoreycoverisanimportant elementfortrainingandtoprovide bufferzonesaroundspecificactivities -andhasalsoresultedinbenefitsto wildlife.

InRangeWest,twobreedingpairsof PowerfulOwlsharetheirrespective favouritebreedinggullieswithArmy personneltraininghowtopatrolat nightandonepairlives'nextdoor'toa grenaderange.Areasusedforlive firingareessentialfortrainingand equallyimportantforwildlife.Breeding pairsofBushStone -curlewandBarkingOwlhavebeenpresentforatleast 9yearsimmediatelyeithersideofthe mainstaticfiringpointusedforgunnerytrainingbyarmouredvehicles.

Theycontinuetoimprovethemanagementofthesiteandtoundertakemanagementactionsthatwillsustain Puckapunyalforthenext100years.

### Periwinkle (Vinca major)

Periwinkleisacreepingplantthatis nativetoEuropeandnorthernAfrica andhasbeenintroducedtoothercontinentsasanornamentalplantormedicinalherb.

Periwinkle'sbroad -leavedrunners formadensemat, shading outnative plants and competing formoisture and nutrients.

- •Itmainlyspreadsvegetativelybut somepatchesalsoproduceseeds.
- •Verysmallisolatedpatches(<1m2) canbedugout.Stemandrootfragmentscanresproutsoallplantmaterialneedstoberemovedfromthesite anddisposedofappropriately.
- Herbicidetreatmentcanbeeffective ifappliedwhenplantsareactively growingandfollowedup.
- •Alongwaterways,particularcareis neededwithphysicalorchemical treatmentstopreventerosionand contamination.Theremayberestrictionsonchemicaluse.
- Alltreatmentneedstobefollowed upforseveralyears.
