GANGGANGCOCKATOOSarenot uncommoninourbush, buttheyarea threatenedspecies, because of loss of habitatand tree hollowloss. Theyare greymedium -sizedcockatoos, the male has a beautiful redhead. Hawthorn berries area favourite food, so if you have a hawthorn hedge, treasure it! Gang -gangsarenearly always seen in pairs or small flocks, and their rather growly voices when feeding in Eucalypts, are often the indication of their presence.
