Steve'sScottishgreat -grandfather, ArchibaldMcAlpin,acarpenter,with hiswifeand10childrenestablisheda successfulwheelbarrow -makingbusinessattheVictoriangoldfieldsinthe 1850s.Oneofthese10,another Archibald,withhiswife,(AliceWare), wasaselectorinHighlandsinthe 1880s.Thefarmwaslatertakenonby Steve'sfather,Archieandhiswife (JanetLade).Stevestilllivesinthe samehouse,withhispartner,Paula, anddaughterEmily.Ben,Stuartand Katevisitfrequently.

StevewaseducatedatHighlands Primary, YeaHighandWangaratta Tech, wherehedidawoolclassing andfarmingcourses. Hesayshe shouldhavedoneengineering, but taughthimselftoweldandbecamean inventor.

Hewon10prizesattheMelbourne ShowforFarmInventions,and3for BestWelder.In1980,hismostquirky inventionwashisfamoussheep drawn"chariot".In1984,hearrivedat hisweddingtoKimPadgettinthe chariot.Pictureswereflashedaround theworld,and2mediahelicopters landedontheYeaRec.

Steve, Peter Yorston and Russell Ralph, in the chariot, led a Farmers' Marchin Melbournein 1985, and also made head lines...

Forabout20years, Steveandhis latemothermadesheepskinbootsto supplementlowfarmincomes. Steve wasafoundingmemberoftheold "HighlandsClub", theiractivities includedRaces, WoolshedDances, Drama, golf, and cards, and whatfun they all had! Stevemade 2 rafts for the Goulburn River, until they all nearly drowned on a serious snag!

SteveworkedintheMiningindustry inWAfor6monthswithRickMcAlpin andNickGardiner.From1984to 1997,SteveandKimraised4children,andStevestartedproductionof hismostsuccessfulinventions,a chainsawsharpeningjig,andafirewoodcuttingholder.Thesehavebeen soldintheir1000satfielddays throughoutVictoria.

Formanyyears, Stevehasbeen active in the Highlands - Caveat CFA, and on the Hall Committee. He is always willing, and capable, of lending a hand anywhere it sneeded and is a kind and gentleman.
