OneSteel(Waratah)hadapricerise atthebeginningofthemonthandwe areexpectinganotheronesoon,possiblyasearlyasnextmonth.Many popularlinesarenowon6to8weeks backorderasOneSteelstruggleto meetdemand. Mostofthealternate wirecompanieshavealsojustincreasedprices.

SimsSteelhaveapricerisecoming onthefirstofnextmonth. Thiseffects RHS, angleironetc. Price increases Gates and fittings5 -15% Chainmesh 18% Pipe 25% OILFreightcompanies are now passing on the increased cost of fuel. Many suppliers have increased their fuelley with some applying a levy for the first time. This has lifted the price of landed product generally.
