WhileworkingforGregYoung,Mat becameinspiredtoplantnativetrees andshrubsonhisinitiallybareblock. Itisnowahavenforbirdsandhasa widearrayofvegetation.Mattextendedhishouseandsheds, usingre cycledmaterialswherepossible, and hasaspectacularviewtoWagg's rangeandWhiteheadsCreekvalley.

Herearesometipstokeepyourbackyard,farm,localbushlandandwaterwaysweedfree.

Gettoknowthelocalweedsinyour area. ContactyourlocalcouncilWeed Officer, Bushcare or Landcare Group or Agronomist.

Beawarethatweedseedsaretransportedonvehicles,trailers,clothing, shoes,insoilandinpetfurandhair.

Alwayssticktodesignatedtracks whenwalking,horseriding,driving, ridingpushbikesormotorbikesthrough naturalareas.

Disposeofweedsthatarealready seedingorreadilyabletoreproduce vegetativelybyplacingtheminablack plasticbag, sealingitand bakingit in the sunforacouple of weeks prior to placing it in the bin.

Compostordisposeofothergarden andgreenwasteincouncilgreen wastecollectionsorbycarefullytransportingittoyourcouncil'sgreenwaste tip.NEVERdumpgardenwasteover thebackfenceorinbushland.

Alwayscovertrailerswhentransportingplantmaterialtopreventseedsand otherliveplantmaterialfallingoff.

Considercarefullywhatplantsyoubuy forpondsandaquariums.

Neverdumpaquariumwaterorcontentsdowndrainsorintowaterways

Importedplants, bulbs and seed including those ordered over the Internet or through mail order must be cleared before coming into the country. Check the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service website before ordering plant material.
