PURPLECORALPEA(orFalseSasparilla) -Hardenbergiaviolaceae,is usuallyaclimber,withstemstwisting roundotherplants.Itflowersinwinter andspring,andhasvioletpea - flowers,butpinkandwhiteformsare alsofound.Itisapopularandhardy gardenplant,andcanbepropagated easilyfromscarifiedseedorcuttings. Inthegardenitrespondswelltopruning,andflowersbestinfullsun.



VICTORIA PREPARES FOR LOCUST THREAT

Trinc desserveds

TheBrumbyGovernmenthasencouragedallVictorianstobeonalertas thestatepreparesforaseriouslocust outbreak,AgricultureMinisterJoe Helpersaidtoday.

MrHelpersaidVictoria'scropsand pasturescouldbeunderthreatwith thepossibilitythatplaguelocusteggs willbehatchingduringspringinNorthernVictoria.

Egg-bearinglocustshavebeenre-cordedthroughoutanareaofapproximately1.24millionhectares(ha)in NorthernVictoria,particularlyinthe irrigationregionnorthofShepparton duringthisyear'sautumn.

"Expertswillbeonhandtoprovide landholderswithadviceonhowtodeal withthethreatoflocustsincludinghow andwhentospray,whattypesof chemicalstouseandsafetechniques.

"AllVictoriansareencouragedtobe vigilantinreportinganysightingsof locuststotheDPlsowecanmonitor locustpopulationsandmovementand theDepartmentcanprovideadviceon howtocontrolthem."

Did you know that rabbits are increasing Global Warming?

AccordingtoarecentstudyinNorth WestVictoriarabbitbrowsingonnativeseedlingshasresultedinthefailureofwoodlandstoregeneratenaturally. The studyfoundthatthe continual destruction of Pine - Bulokewoodlandseedlingsbyrabbitsisinstrumentalin preventing carbon sequestration (collecting or trapping carbon from the atmosphere) acrosshundred softhousands of hectares of land in North - West Victoria.

Rabbitnumbersneedtobeextremely low -lessthanonerabbitperhectare forsuccessfulregeneration.

Thecostofrabbitcontrolisestimated tobeaslittleas\$30 -50perhectare includingon -goingmaintenance.

ThomasAustinintroducedrabbitsto Australiain1859forhuntingpurposes.Withnonaturalpredatorsand littersoffiveormorekittensupto seventimesayear,rabbitsquickly becameaproblemacrossAustralia.

Asrabbitnumbersreachedthehundredsofmillions, vegetationwas strippedofleaves and bark, killing plants and leaving the soil vulnerable toerosion.

Farmersandscientistshaveemployedmanycontrolmethodsover time,includingrippingandfumigating warrens,trapping,shooting,baiting andintroducingbiologicalcontrol agentssuchasmyxomatosisand calicivirus. Effectiverabbitcontrol requirestheintegrateduseofallthese techniques.

"Locustsareeasiesttocontrolduring theirearlystagesashopperswhen theyareunabletofly. Oncetheybecomeadults, controlmeasuresbecomemuchmore difficult and expensive," Dr Tomkinssaid.

Adultlocustshavebeenknowntofly upto700kilometresovernightand canbedrivensouthbynortherly winds.
