

TREELUCERNE -(Cystisuspalmensis)isatallgrowingwoodyshrubor smalltreewithgrey -greenleavesand aspreadingcanopy. It has white, honey-scentedpeaflowersinlate wintertoearlyspring. The smalldark seedsareproducedinprolific amountsinseedpods.TreeLucerne isabletodominatenativevegetation, andhasbecomeaweedofroadside vergesandbushland,fore.g.inRuffy andCreighton'sCreek.Ithasbeen valuedasadroughtresistantfodder plant, for its highlevels of essential nitrogen, and for fixing nitrogenin degradedsoils, and does not appear tobeaprobleminplantationswhich aresurroundedbygrazedland. However, careshould be exercised if consideringplantingitanywhere.Becauseitisnotanative, it is quite lawfultoharvestitfromroadsidesand feedittoyourstock!
