THE

BRIENCOOK, JAMESSIMONSEN, 2 ½y.o.MAGGIE, PETERCOWLING and LIZNIXON with NED(2y.o) and TILLY (7mths), are happily conducting an interesting ecological and social projection 320 acres of land, off Blue Top Road at Highlands.

Thelandwasoriginallyovergrazed andcrawlingwithrabbits, alsothickly endowedwithPaterson'sCurse. What achallenge! Theyboughtthelandin 2005, withtheaimofforestingpartsof theblockforhighendsaw -logproduction, re-vegetatingotherpartsbycreatingcorridorsconnectingtheexisting forests with standsofpaddocktrees with local indigenous species, and restoring birdand native animal habitat, and restoring thebalance of the landtoquality native grasspasture.

Theirbaseonthepropertyisashelteredareasurroundedbyanatural landscapeofgraniteboulders,with wonderfulviewsinnearlyeverydirection.Notfarawayisasecludedcopse ofmessmatesandredstringybarks, withnotone,buttwo,wedge -tailed eagle'snests.Thesewillbeclosely watchedthisseason,forsignsofactivity.

Theownershavebeengrowingtheir owntube -stockfromseedsgathered ontheproperty.

Sofar,theyhaveplantedover2000 units,plus3000inaplantation. The drought,especiallythatsummer of 2006-7, whennospringrainfell, took aserioustoll, and many plantings werelost. However, Brien James and Peterhaven ot been deterred; in fact, they have been equite fanatic and have been seen planting by carlights, in the rain, at 8 pm at night, and in the recents now!

Theycampinacontainerandtents andhavewonderfulplansforbuilding acompletelyeco -friendlyhouseinthe nearfuture.

BriencomesfromCaliforniaandhis originalprofessionwasaproperty lawyer;henowmanagestoinclude sometimeasavolunteerguideatthe BotanicalgardensinMelbourne.
