RUFFY CHANGES FACE

There is a changing face to the streetscape of the tablelands village of Ruffy. Since the formation of the Ruffy Community Action group around 5 years ago the local community has come together to upgrade and revitalize the look and feel of this delightful sleepy local hamlet.

The Community Hall has been upgraded with well crafted additions to the outdoor entertainment area including a stone fireplace and sympathetic landscaping.

A soldiers' memorial has been erected and topped with plaques commemorating the four local boys who didn't come home. Four Manchurian pear trees stand guard over the memorial and the old hazardous elm trees that had lined the northern end of the main street have been replaced with new semi-mature specimens.

Anyone visiting Ruffy's signature enterprise, the widely renowned Ruffy Produce Store couldn't help but be impressed with the landscaping around the magnificent oak trees that welcome visitors out front.

The most recent works are currently underway at the Tablelands Community Centre where a low stone wall is being constructed by Stephen Visser who trained under local identity Taffy Jukes. The design of the wall is in keeping with the overall streetscape and has been approved and funded through the Ruffy Action Group. Stephen's brief was to create an attractive but functional facade for the old school using granite collected from local private properties.

FOX ON THE RUN HUNTING COMPETITION




