Hyacinth Orchid

Dipodeum roseum

Spring is the peak season for orchids in Victoria, but the biggest and showiest waits until summer to burst out in bright display.



The hyacinth orchid is found in woodland and flowers from around Christmas to February.

It grows to about knee-high and has 20 to 30 pink flowers, which vary from no spots to lots of spots.

The stalk is usually purple, and before the flowers appear the shape is rather like an asparagus spear.

This year we had a patch with about 15 stalks that I was keeping an eye on.

Two had green rather than purple stalks and I was interested to see what

stalks and I was interested to see wha the flowers would be like, but something (we suspect wallabies) ate the whole lot before they flowered.


