Poultry Auctions...... love them!

Very few people know that Euroa regularly hosts one of Victoria's biggest and best poultry auctions.

Every 2nd month hundreds of fanciers from across Southern Australia spend their Sunday afternoon at the Euroa show grounds trading chooks, ducks, turkeys, geese and even boxes of fertile eggs.

The range of breeds up for sale is amazing. So many different colours and sizes. Prices vary greatly according to the season. This month it was a sellers market, with prices three times greater that those at the April auction. In April I paid \$2 each for quails, today I spent \$35 for a pair. Stud rare breed trios were going up to \$199, sometimes you can be lucky and get them for \$15 each.

I love the broad cross section of the community that attend with many cultures, backgrounds and ages mingling in hot pursuit of their favourite chook breeds. Metry's Auction Company and Euroa Poultry Club run these events.

Check their website for the dates of upcoming auctions.

The next one is on October 6th 2013 starting 11am.
