This groundcover creeper is inconspicuous most of the year, until spring when the bright red



pea-flowers suddenly emerge. The leaves are in threes, like clover and have crinkly edges.

It can sprawl over a metre or more. I've only seen it occasionally around the district, but we came across one on September's Highland ramble.

Aboriginals used the stems for twine and sucked nectar from the flowers.

I assume the name relates to the colour of postmen's uniforms at some time in the past, because I've never seen a postman like this.


