Our Strathbogie Ranges & Upper Goulburn districts are blessed to have such a stunning array of home grown creative arts, food, wine and festivals; and many of them will come together over the month of January in the "Yea Arts Carnivale".

Following the official opening on 19th January at the Twilight Market on High St. Yea, there will be a cornucopia of arts, food & music events across the district until the conclusion of the Carnivale on 27th January.

Of particular interest to Granite News readers will be the events at the Hillcrest Gallery, Rocky Passes Winery and the Highlands Hall

Dennis Spiteri's 'Hillcrest' studio/gallery at Highlands was opened in 2004. This striking building, set atop the tranquil rolling hills of central Victoria and looking over to the distant Tallarook Ranges, has become a popular cultural attraction in the region. As a professional artist for forty-one years, Dennis has built his studio/gallery to produce and exhibit his work. The large scale of the building has been designed to fit around his large-scale abstract paintings. This marvellous venue has also been used for musical performances in conjunction with his exhibitions.







Rocky Passes Estate at Whiteheads Creek is a cool-climate vineyard and boutique winery that produces award-winning, artisan-made red wines.

The cellar door, inspired by the simple cantinas of Europe and Sth America, is the heart of Rocky Passes serving tapas and Argentinean BBQs. Over the Yea Arts Carnivale weekends, you can enjoy tapas and wine, a collection of local art and "Driven by the Wood" an exhibition of fine furniture made by Vitto Oles.
