

From Penang to Longwood

A presentation by Paul Macgregor February 28th from 6.30pm at 'Rocky Passes'

Paul Macgregor, is best known locally for organising the Black Market food swap market in the Seymour district. Paul is also an historian, and was curator of the Chinese Museum in Melbourne from 1990-2005. He still works as a freelance historian and has spent the last 10 years uncovering the story of Lowe Kong Meng, one of the great untold celebrities of our colonial history.

At our February Tapas Night, you have an opportunity to learn about Lowe Kong Meng, a Chinese gold-rush merchant based in colonial Melbourne. He was one of the earliest "tree-changers" in our district. In the 1880s he bought a property near Longwood which he named Karep, and his descendants then became well-known locally for their horse racing. "It is with regret that I have to inform ou of the possibility that there may be an arsonist active within the Whiteheads Creek area.

The fire on the corner of Hall Lane and Kobyboyn Rd is being treated as suspicious. We have been asked to be vigilant in taking notice of anything suspicious, not vigilantes!

Please call the police with any concerns, don't take matters into your own hands. Please also let me know.

If you see people pulled over on the side of the road, note down the number plate, colour and vehicle type and anything distinguishing that may be helpful if there is an incident and if you're comfortable, wind down the window and ask if they are okay. It may be enough to stop someone doing the wrong thing!

A guick reminder to carry water and/or a fire extinguisher on board if you are planning to use power tools, chainsaws, tractors, mowers and the like and please be mindful of the weather conditions and fire danger ratings before deciding to use them.



And now, a few words from THE MINISTER.....about WATER......

I have released the **Water Bill Exposure Draft** to provide Victorians the opportunity to comment on proposed changes to the state's water laws.

Release of the Exposure Draft is an important milestone in the Victorian Government's comprehensive review of Victoria's water laws. This review will deliver a more effective legislative framework for water management and use in Victoria. The review has brought the *Water Act 1989* and the *Water Industry Act 1994* into a single new streamlined Water Act that reflects contemporary practice in water management and government policy.

The Exposure Draft gives Victorians a chance to provide feedback on the proposed changes before they are passed as law.

There will be an eight week consultation period from today until **14 February 2014** for submissions to be received on the Exposure Draft.

A plain English Explanatory Guide is being released with the Exposure Draft. It sets out the main proposals in the Exposure Draft to help stakeholders understand the proposals and provide comment on the Bill before it is finalised and introduced to Parliament in 2014.

A series of public forums on the Exposure Draft will be held across regional Victoria and Melbourne in late January and early February 2014.

More information about these forums will be provided in the coming weeks.

Information sheets and a table showing where to find the equivalent provisions from the *Water Act 1989* and the *Water Industry Act 1994* in the Exposure Draft are also available.

In 2012, I appointed an expert Advisory Panel with legal and water industry experience to oversee the review and make recommendations. The panel is chaired by John Adams, with John Wilkinson, Stuart Gemmill, Russell Cooper and Robert Sadler panel members.

When the submission period has closed, the Advisory Panel and I will consider the comments which have been received through the consultation period and finalise the Water Bill. The aim is to introduce the final Water Bill to Parliament in 2014.
