THE ECONOMIC BENEFITS of BIODIVERSITY - By Janet Hagen

SHADE — Heat stress can markedly reduce stock fertility, milk production and weight gain, and increases mortality of calves and sheep.

- * Heat stress may cause abortion and certainly causes calves to be born undersized and consequently more susceptible to heat stress.
- * Cows resting in the shade continue to chew their cud whereas cows in the hot sun abstain. Because rumination increases the heat produced by the body, heat-stressed stock abstain from eating so as to reduce metabolic heat production.

After drinking and grazing, chewing cud is the third most important activity of cattle, so abstaining directly affects productivity.



PASTURE GROWTH — Sheltered pastures lose 12mm of water less than open pastures during the spring growing season in NSW.

- * Protected parts of the farm have an estimated 20% increase in average annual pasture growth.
- * Gross value of pasture output is at its highest level when the proportion of tree area across a *foxy* farm is at 34%.
- * Lighter stocking rates on native grasslands showed benefits in terms of improved livestock performance, reduced drought costs and changed farm overhead costs. On farm benefits are expected to almost outweigh the direct effect of the reduction in sheep numbers.

WASP NESTS

I found this unusual wasp nest on the side of our house.



We've had mud nests before but never one with a trumpet and unfortunately we didn't see the wasp building it.

It led me to try and find out a bit about
Australian wasps and I was surprised at
the many varieties there are, and the
different nesting habits.
Most are solitary, and as well as mud
nests there are species that make
burrows or form galls on plants, or lay

a caterpillar.

There are even cuckoo wasps which lay their eggs in mud wasp's nests.

Mud wasps have multiple sealed chambers in each nest, with a dead or paralysed prey item in each chamber for the wasp larva to feed on when it hatches.

My best guess at identifying the trumpetbuilder is **Abispa** *splendida*, but I wouldn't put money on it.

Paper wasps nest communally and we had one on our verandah a couple of years ago.



The nests are made of chewed up plant matter and usually hang from a stalk, a bit like an upside-down mushroom.

Often there is only one breeding queen in the hive, a bit like bees.

Wasps are useful in pollinating, and also for controlling caterpillars and pest insects. In many species the adults feed on nectar but catch prey to feed their young. Some of the Aussie wasps do have a painful sting but I don't think they're dangerous like the European wasp.
