COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH delivers GRANITE NEWS

Collaboration between Professor
John Clemens at South Africa's Stellenbosch
University and Professor Neil Phillips from
Melbourne University and their
colleagues & students has created the
Melbourne-Stellenbosch
Strathbogie Granite Project.

The initial phase of the Strathbogie Granite
Project is being finalised, and researchers from
Australia & South Africa have learned much
about this large granite mass in
central Victoria.

Clemens and Phillips were involved in initial studies of the Strathbogie granite as post-graduate students at Monash in the 1970s, and subsequently worked with CSIRO colleagues and Professor Janet Hergt of University of Melbourne.

Numerous informal excursions into the Strathbogie Ranges over the last decade have revealed many unanswered questions and some remarkable features of this granite. The field phase of the latest collaborative research started in 2010 with a visit by Clemens to Australia.

The granite extends for 90 km from the Tallarook plateau to Mt Samaria and has formed a major physical barrier across Victoria.

It is primarily the existence of this granite that explains why the main freeway from Melbourne to Sydney leaves Melbourne heading north, and only after Avenel does it turn northeast towards Sydney.

The research team believes that the granite came into its present position as a liquid magma at temperatures over 800 °C.

The molten material making up the magma came from 20 km deep and rose through the Earth's upper crust because of its relative buoyancy.

This all happened during a very violent period of Victoria's history, 370 million years ago, when there were huge earth movements, many other granites, and large explosive volcanoes.

The magma ascended vertically but a new idea is that much of the final movement was horizontal, and the researchers have found a number of places where the horizontal layers can be seen today.

The Strathbogie plateau is a mixture of state forest and private land, and land owners have been generous in providing access for this research over the years.

A subsidiary aspect of the study will look at the cooling of the magma, how the large rock pavements and tors form, and how the cracks that developed during the cooling might influence groundwater flow.

Interestingly, although the Strathbogie granite is quite unusual, it shares some strange

features with the large granite bodies near

Cape Town and Stellenbosch.
