Cordierite is the black fleck material that is commonly, and almost exclusively, found in granite within the Strathbogie Ranges.

Cordierite, which was discovered in 1813, is named after the French geologist Louis Cordier (1777–1861)

Cordierite is a magnesium iron aluminium cyclosilicate.


