What is that in your paddock?

Don't use the excuse that it escaped from the neighbour's property, weed control is the responsibility of every landholder and land user.

Each year HCCC Landcare, Murrindindi, and Strathbogie Councils do their bit by funding the treatment of hundreds of kilometres of roadsides for weeds in the local area.

Weeds such as Blackberry, Briar, Gorse, Broom, Holly, Ivy, St John's Wort and Paterson's Curse are on the target list. Weeds are damaging to the environment as they are:

Highly invasive
Restrict access to watercourses
Restrict the growth of natives
and pastures by limiting sunlight
Provide harbour & food for pests
such as rabbits and foxes
Unpalatable/ toxic to grazing
animals

Can become a fire hazard

The most recent project was contracting Hillside Weed Spraying to treat blackberries along roadsides in the Highlands area. This area was chosen to coincide with the DEPI compliance

project which had issued over 30 notices to landholders.

With a combined effort from all landholders we can limit the spread and growth of environmental weeds. The season for treatment of weeds such as blackberry is now. We encourage you and your neighbour to check your paddocks, bushland and water ways and have weeds treated.


