# Note from 'The Granite Guy', Prof. Neil Phillips

Many people have been generous supporters of the **Strathbogie Granite Project** over recent years: we are very grateful for the encouragement and access to granite outcrops on private property.

I hope that our community feedback sessions have been of some value in explaining what the granite research is about, and outlining some of our findings. We plan to continue the feedback as appropriate and as invited.

As we outlined recently at our evening session at Gooram, Professor Sandy Cruden (Head of Geosciences at Monash University) and I have offered two Honours projects in the Strathbogie area for 2015.

These have been accepted by Rachael Maxwell and Andrew Gordon who will carry out geophysical work in the district from Euroa to Gobur.

Monash University Honours students Rachael & Andrew begin their research project on the Strathbogie granite.

It is also important that the students have some independent time to think through their own research approaches and conclusions.

The endpoint of these two Honours projects will be higher level training for these senior students, and testing of some of our (unconstrained) ideas from the 2010-2014 field work by John Clemens and myself.

Rachael and Andrew will be doing their fieldwork during April with possible follow-up visits later in the year.

They will be taking readings of gravity and magnetic susceptibility of the rocks, and some of this will require drilling and collecting samples about the size of a wine bottle cork.

They are under instruction to seek permission from landowners before any work is done on private property.

I will be helping to establish the field component of the research on Sat 11<sup>th</sup> April, and both Sandy and I will revisit the researchers as they proceed.


