BLACKBERRY MANAGEMENT AT GOBUR-MERTON TRIALS

Many Victorian properties have unproductive and vermin ridden areas of blackberry infestation, often along water courses where old long established bushes can be several metres high and extend over a significant area.

Their removal or management often defies many farmers and the sheer challenge of the task can prevent a return of the infested area to permanent productive pastures.

The Victorian Blackberry Taskforce (VBT) works on a partnership basis to inform, encourage & support community action groups to reduce blackberry infestation on farms & lifestyle properties.

Established in 2013 the Merton-Cathkin Blackberry Action Group (MCBAG) is working across the Shires of Murrindindi and Mansfield with landowners under voluntary agreements to control or remove blackberry infestations.

In its short history over 50 landowners have joined the project with some 500 hectares of blackberry infestation treated to date.

A recent Field Day on two properties-Kaloomah at Gobur and Avalon at Merton showed the progress with trials. The strategy is to reduce the downstream infestation in the Yarck valley and to improve wildlife access to the Creek.

Cam Paterson is the MCBAG project officer funded by VBT. He says that the project trial work has provided useful information on the most effective herbicide applications and how to create an effective blackberry management plan.



"It is also clear that there are a lot of opportunities for adjoining property owners to work together to lower the cost of eradication and to derive the maximum benefits."
