
FOX ON THE RUN LUNCH AND PRESENTATION

CLASSICAL MUSIC in the BUSH

Two of Australia's best musicians in the field of Baroque Music will perform on 2nd August at the music salon of Peter Hagen.

These highly gifted and specialised musicians will perform music from the court of Dresden the way it was played in the middle of the 18th century. Greg Dikmans plays a special wooden flute with no keys and Lucinda Moon, former leader of the well-known Australian Brandenburg Orchestra, plays on a violin with real gut strings. Joined by Peter Hagen on harpsichord, the three musicians have researched performance practices and music from the baroque era which spanned roughly from 1600 – 1760. They aim to play it as it would have been played and experienced in the days when kings and queens as well as dukes and duchesses all owned their own personal orchestras. During the colder months what could be nicer on a Sunday afternoon than listening to music fit for kings and queens, by the warmth of a cosy fire. Chat to the performers afterwards with complimentary drinks and small plates of finger food are available for an extra \$8.50 to make the occasion even more appealing. Many people are regulars at these events and the local music loving family is growing as people realise they do not have to travel to Melbourne to hear quality classical music.

You can do all this at the "Salon" of Peter Hagen in the middle of a peaceful bush setting between Broadford and Kilmore.
