# STRATHBOGIE GRANITE PROJECT

The Strathbogie granite geology project has been progressing this year with field work around the Tallarook plateau, Highlands -Ruffy - Avenel area, and sites farther east towards Strathbogie. Rachael Maxwell and Andrew Gordon have been collecting field data for their Honours research projects at Monash University under the co-supervision of Sandy Cruden and Neil Phillips. Rachael has been taking careful readings of gravity, and Andrew has been collecting small samples on which the magnetic properties are measured back at Monash. Both projects help towards our understanding of this 2000 sq km granite mass.





Key players in the Strathbogie granite project, Professor John Clemens of Stellenbosch University in South Africa, and Neil Phillips, have been involved in discussions to consider NE Victoria as the base for a major international granite conference and field trips, probably in 2017.
