The HCCC LANDCARE 'Fox on the Run' Programme has paid dividends again in 2015.

A good crowd of local folks and fox-shooters gathered for lunch at the Terip Rec Reserve last Sunday to celebrate the end of the two month programme and to applaud the winners.

HCCC Landcare President Michael Kopanica made the presentations and congratulated the winners and other participants for their ongoing dedication to keeping fox numbers down in our catchment.

For the two months of June & July there were 386 foxes shot and comments from local farmers and residents were very positive about the effect that this annual programme is having on reducing the fox population.
