## **Hughes Creek Habitat Restored after High Flow Event**

I'm happy to report a very successful and enjoyable day was had by all on the Hughes Creek on 19th January, installing more timber for Macquarie perch harbour following the recent high flow event that had dislodged some of the work that we had completed last year.

It is with great thanks to property manager, David Freeman and Gary McLarty, that further in-stream habitat was created to support the Macquarie perch within their stronghold on the Hughes Creek. Identified by Will Trueman as a priority area for habitat improvement, large dead trees and several log jams were installed within a 300m stretch to enhance connectivity between the refuge pools known to support Macquarie perch.

With valued input and assistance from Will and Renae Ayres (ARI), along with several members of Native Fish Australia (NFA) and GB CMA staff, we were able to relocate selected timber sourced from the adjoining land into the channel.



Smaller limbs were manoeuvred into log jams by the helping hands, with efforts made to secure the timber in place to create bed scour and shelter.

Though these smaller pieces are more liable to shift in high flows, it is expected they will not progress far before becoming caught up in

the large complex wood installed downstream.

An end of the day highlight was spotting a juvenile Macquarie perch, along with a small common yabby (*Cherax destructor*), making use of the new log jam shelter several of us stood beside.

Having learnt what was possible with man power and a tractor, we may consider another stage of works in this remote area in the future.

First however we will evaluate the change over time in the channel form,

particularly the sediment stores which had altered following the recent high flow event. It will also be very interesting and hopefully reaffirming, to see what Macquarie perch are collected from these structures when the fish surveys are again undertaken in the autumn.
