

# Light Horse Memorial Park—Seymour "Open Day"



The Light Horse Memorial Park Committee invites you an open day on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> May at 10.00 AM.

There will be a traditional Aussie morning tea of scones lamingtons and Anzac biscuits while the billy boils, followed at 11.00AM by guest speaker, historian David Howell.

David was a guide at the Shrine of Remembrance for some years, and is now leading groups along the Kokoda Track, and to battlefields in France and Belgium.

He will be speaking about the valiant 37th Infantry Battalion, "Seymour's Own" who left Seymour on 2<sup>nd</sup> of June 1916 heading for France and Belgium. Theirs in a truly remarkable tale, and at the end they were down to fighting strength of just 90, of the original 1000 men. Refusing to be separated, they became known as "The Indivisibles".

There will also be a group of "living historians" in World War 1 uniform who will set up Army bell tents, and have a display of various World War 1 memorabilia.

A set of found army badges from around the area will be presented to the park on the day by Kevin and Margot Green, followed by guided tours of the Park, and a light lunch.


