Lumber Jack makes Beautiful Music

Jack Norton was born in London and lived in Canada & South Africa before settling in Melbourne with his family at the age of eight, a foundation upon which he has built a life of intriguing diversity. Music was encouraged within the family and Jack spent time at the Victorian College of the Arts in pursuit of a formal music education, but not before qualifying as a wool classer. When questioned about this, Jack



explains that he reckoned wool classing would give him the chance to earn while travelling and seeing more of the Australian country & outback that he loves so dearly.

Having developed a keen interest in Renaissance music at the VCA, in 1980 Jack enrolled in a degree at the London School of Music specialising in the Lute. To get to London he chose to

make his way across country to England via the Khyber Pass, Afghanistan, Iran and Turkey. This odyssey spawned some incredible life experiences

for Jack that space doesn't allow us to relate here.

Jack had always been fascinated by timber, its huge range of species and their varied applications and uses.

So it was natural for him to explore the use of timbers in musical instruments and he humbly displays an impressive range of stringed instruments which have been



manufactured from local timbers that he has selected and milled .

Now ensconced at Ruffy, Jack has set himself up to produce custom furniture, having been a furniture maker for Nicholas Dattner.

He also has a Lucas Mill for processing timber on farmers' properties, a service that is in high demand in Victoria's north east.

Spending time one-on-one with Jack Norton is a delightfully enriching experience; having him as a permanent resident of our Tablelands community is a bonus for all of us.


