TONY CHANGES GEARS and GOES GARLIC

From driving road-trains in the top end of Australia to growing organic garlic at the top of our Tableland, Tony Murphy has made just about the ultimate tree change. Now residing at Longwood East, Tony reckons that he's found his nirvana and is passionate about the prospects of developing his organic garlic business.

However, like most people, there's also lot's of other really interesting stuff that he's done along the way. As a Melbourne boy Tony trained as a motor mechanic and worked his way through the trade to what most motor mechanics would consider to be the pinnacle...workshop manager for Glenn Seton's Ford Group A race team. Tony managed Glenn's Bathurst assaults for 6 years and he was

acknowledged within the race-car industry for his ability to set up a race car for optimum performance & handling.

When things changed in Tony's life he took to driving road trains delivering fuel in NT and northern WA. These behemoths have 86 wheels and weigh 163 tonnes. Although now committed to the quiet life on his garlic farm, Tony is still called upon to run fuel roadtrains to northern Australia to supply the national Group A motor race program.



Since late 2014 Tony has been developing his organic garlic operation with 8 varieties that he intends to direct market through Farmer's Markets and online sales. He says that most folks don't realise that good quality fresh garlic can be stored for up to 12 months and he will be marketing plaited products that can be stored for long periods. His first crop was a success and has been used for seed-stock with his initial commercial garlic due for the market in February 2017. Anyone interested in locally grown organic garlic should watch this space as we'll let you know when Tony's product is available. 


