Identifying Eucalypts



On a recent visit to the National Arboretum, Canberra we picked up a copy of 'Gardener's Companion to EUCALYPTS' in the hope of correctly identifying a particular gum tree on my place but alas, even with the help of this reference guide we're still not certain about the species of this attractive eucalypt. I've been inclined to call it a Tasmanian blue gum due to the ovate young leaves formed opposing on squared stems transforming to sickle shaped leaves at maturity. However the trunk & bark don't seem consistent with the Tasmanian blue gum. Can any GN readers accurately identify this tree? By Don Cook






he large dimpled buds are similar to the Blue Gum
