The Charlton Window Resurrected

Granite News readers have shared in the restoration of the "Charlton Window" from the inception of the project, and it is hard to believe that after 80 years of neglect, from behind the grime and damage this rare and beautiful Boer War Memorial window has emerged in all its glorious colour and vibrancy.



The window was erected as a memorial to one young man, Private John Charlton of Castle Creek, who fought with the 5th Contingent of the Victorian Mounted Rifles in South Africa. He died of enteric fever on 16 August 1901.

However, as one of only a handful of Boer War stained glass memorials in Victoria, and the only one in the Strathbogie area, it became a

symbol of mourning for the community and a precursor to the boundless service and tragic losses of the First World War.

By using the symbolic imagery of the window it is possible to engage a new generation about themes relating to the Boer War. The Victorian Mounted Rifles became the Light Horse and then the Royal Australian Armoured Corps and Cavalry Regiment.

At 3.30pm, Sunday 20th November, the Charlton Memorial Window will be unveiled and re-dedicated in an impressive ceremony at

led by a Lance Guard of the School of Armour, Royal Australian Armoured Corps, Puckapunyal.
