#### **ERWIN & JIM GET RUFFIANS RUMINATING**

When the Shire of Strathbogie restructured their Community Action Groups, Ruffy's CAG Chairman Erwin Weinmann made it his mission to ensure that any re-set of the Community Action Group structure would be both embraced by and beneficial for the Ruffy community.

In pursuit of his mission, Erwin promoted and delivered a community meeting that gave all residents a chance to express their views and to prioritise the issues they believed would most benefit the community in the long term. Thirty people turned out to participate in the community forum held at the Ruffy Community Hall on Friday August 4th.

Terip Terip's Jim Davidson, a respected independent facilitator, led an evening of vibrant discussion that considered two broad components —

- !/ What are the attractive elements of living in Ruffy
- 2/ What are the things that could be improved, and who should be responsible for driving those improvements.



After two hours of robust but respectful discourse, the results were in.

### Good Things about living in Ruffy:

People – community spirit, friendly, inclusive, supportive & accepting Geographic Location — accessibility, safety and security Quaint & Unique—peaceful, remote, quiet, separateness of tableland Climate – distinct seasons, summer breezes due to elevation Environment – clean air, waterways, landscape, native vegetation & fauna Community assets:

- \* Tablelands Community Centre (TCC) \* Ruffy Recreation Reserve
- \* Ruffy Hall \* CFA \* Ruffy Store social hub for locals and weekenders

### Top Five things that could be improved:

- \* Support for people to stay in the district
- labour exchange, barter, community transport
- \* Informal, non-commercial community hub more social interaction
- \* Improved & regular maintenance of roads and roadside trees
- \* Mobile phone coverage
- \* Continued care/preservation of landscape & active conservation

Mt Wombat Ward Councillor Alistair Thomson closed the meeting with an outline of the Community Planning Reference Groups' structure, and there'll be another meeting held shortly to constitute the Ruffy Reference Group.


