FOX ON THE HOBBLE

HCCC Landcare's annual Fox on the Run competition has returned impressive results over the years, with local hunters regularly shooting grand totals of 400+ foxes for the season.



Each year we've seen the regular teams surrendering scores of tails,

having spent many cold days & nights on the Tablelands in search of the feral pests.

It's an inter-generational sport, with fathers & grandfathers educating their youngsters in the responsible use of firearms as well as patience, endurance and bushcraft.

For 2017 the decision was taken to 'change it up' by rewarding the redemption of the fox's front left foot instead of the tail.

Well, it seems that some of our regular hunters voted with their


