Rainfall outlook from B.O.M

The Bureau's rainfall outlook for spring, issued on 31 August, suggests roughly equal chances of a wetter or drier than average season for most parts of Victoria. The exception is parts of E. Gippsland where it's likely to be wetter than average. Both of Australia's major climate drivers at this time of year, the El Niño-Southern Oscillation (ENSO) & the Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD), remain neutral & this is reflected in the rainfall outlook with no strong widespread signal for a wetter or drier than average season. Day & nighttime temperatures are likely to be warmer than average in most parts, with the strongest odds (+80%) in the east, easing to the west. Warmer than normal sea temperatures to the east of Australia are contributing to the warmer than average outlook.
