FIRE SEASON MAY COME EARLY in 2017-18

The Southern Australia Seasonal Bushfire Outlook 2017 shows the southern fire season is likely to commence earlier and be more active than usual due to a warmer



dry winter and it forecasts a hot summer. CFA Chief Officer Steve Warrington said "The outlook suggests that we could be looking at the commencement of a fire season as early as October and we're preparing our people across the organisation so come October we will be ready to go."

When The Granite News spoke to CFA Rural Fire Brigade captains from Highlands, Terip and Ruffy they agreed that residents and landholders should already have their fire planning well under way.

Terip Terip CFA Captain Geoff Penny said that the local season could still improve with a couple of good rains, because there's plenty of ground water and it's still possible to get bogged. Geoff also highlighted the Murrindindi Shire's burn-off restrictions that forbid large burn-offs after October 15th without a permit. Landholders must familiarise themselves with local Shire restrictions and of course register all burn-offs with CFA on 1800 668511

Highlands CFA Captain Les Lawson emphasised the need for landholders to ensure that they have their own fire-fighting unit, either static or mobile, for their own personal & property protection because on a severe fire danger day there are never enough fire-trucks and response times cannot be guaranteed. Les Lawson also recommends that all residents maintain a fixed telephone landline that does not rely on 240v power. In the event of an emergency the first service to suffer is the electricity supply and as we all know, mobile phone coverage in this area is patchy.

Ruffy CFA Captain George Noye reminded community members to formalise their 'Leave Early or Stay & Defend' strategy for days of Extreme or Code Red Fire Danger.

- * Your plans should include pets & livestock
- * Ensure rapid access to your critical documents
- * Park your motor vehicle fully fuelled and facing your exit
- * All household members should leave in the one vehicle
