


### WHO WAS THAT BLOKE NAMED BILLY?

Marj Leigh dropped in a few weeks ago with some fliers for the Ruffy Car Boot Sale. While she was here she kindly agreed to show me the way up to "Good Morning Billy", the large hill between our properties and a majestic local landmark. Our guests often ask where they can walk in the area and how to get closer to some of those incredible boulders. Marj and I set off in the car and as we got out near to the top she suddenly asked me if I was claustrophobic, to which I replied "well I don't think so" somewhat intrigued to where this was leading...



"I'll show you The Cave " she said. So there I was following Marj into the darkness; a woman who has lived here for most of her life and with whom I had only recently become acquainted. It brought forth a feeling of adventure that I had not had for many years. I followed her blindly into the inky (and possibly snaky) darkness, squeezing between huge granite boulders that had formed tens of thousands of years ago to create a magnificent cave





cave with a local 'elder' of the area. The following week I climbed to the summit with two friends and we located the Pinniger Cairn and some amazing old pine trees just below the summit. I'd love to know more of
