

#### St John Delivers First Aid Awareness on the Tablelands

Living here on the Strathbogie Tablelands is something that none

of us takes for granted. We appreciate and celebrate the peaceful and often pristine environment, the sense of connected remoteness, our vibrant & supportive communities and the clear air. However one of the drawbacks can be the time and distance that we live and work from emergency medical care. Support for community First Aid education has come from Ruffy Artfest, Ruffy CFA, Tablelands Community Centre, Ruffy Recreation Reserve and the Ruffy Community Action Group which underwrote last Sunday's Emergency First Aid Awareness session. The event was organised by Caveat's Melissa McDowall and delivered by St John Ambulance at the Tablelands Community Centre. It was not First Aid Certificate training, but it did equip the participants with valuable information and the confidence to handle an initial response to some common medical emergencies such as snake bite, CPR and the use of the defibrillator.

Fifteen years ago, I believed there should be some civil arrangement for same sex couples, but not call it marriage. At the time, I thought I held a fairly balanced position.
