# Have YOU considered becoming a local councillor?

Nominations to stand as a candidate for local council elections open on Thursday 17 September. The election will be held entirely by post.

'If you would like to represent your community, I encourage you to nominate as a candidate this election,' says Electoral Commissioner Warwick Gately. 'The eligibility requirements for candidates have recently changed. If you are thinking about standing for election, make sure to confirm your eligibility & complete the mandatory online candidate training before lodging your nomination. This includes candidates who are currently or have previously been a councillor.'

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Victorian Electoral Commission's recorded candidate information session will be able to be streamed online from Thursday 3 September and will be complemented by state-wide interactive candidate seminars based on the information session video.

To watch the information session and find out how to join an online interactive seminar, candidates can visit the VEC website at <a href="wec.vic.gov.au">wec.vic.gov.au</a>. The Candidate Handbook is also available on the VEC website.

Candidates must make an appointment during business hours with the Election Manager to lodge their nomination forms and pay their \$250 nomination fee. They must have completed the online candidate training, as this is required by law and will be shown on each candidate's nomination form.

Candidates may make a nomination appointment with the Election Manager by calling 1300 128 939 from Wednesday 16 September. Candidates can also pre-fill a nomination form using the online Candidate Helper

at candidatehelper.vec.vic.gov.au, available from Thursday 3 September.

# **King Parrot** – (Alisterus Scapularis)

The spectacular red and green King-Parrot is found along the east coast and ranges of Australia from Cooktown in Queensland all the way south to Port Campbell in Victoria. They are usually found in rainforests or wet sclerophyll forests where they mostly forage in the trees for their diet of seeds and fruit.

Male Australian King-Parrots are the only Australian parrots with a completely red head. Females are similar to males except that they have a completely green head and breast. Both sexes have a red belly and a green back, with green wings and a long green tail. King parrots are normally encountered in pairs or family groups.

They are seldom seen flying above the tree tops of the dense forests which they inhabit, as they prefer to fly below tree level, weaving in and out through the tree trunks instead. When they are disturbed by a person, they usually fly off with a harsh screech, and often do not land until they are lost to view. Their flight is swift and strong, characterised by deep, rhythmic wing-beats and regularly punctuated with rapid twists and turns.

The adult Crimson Rosella, is similar to the male Australian King-Parrot, but differs by having blue cheeks, shoulders, and tail, a whitish, rather than red, bill and a dark eye. Immature Crimson Rosellas also differ from female and immature King-Parrots by having blue cheeks, a whitish bill and a more yellow-green rather than dark green colouring.

King-Parrots lay their eggs on a bed of decayed wood-dust at the bottom of a deep hollow in the trunk of a tree. Often the entrance is high in the tree (10 m) but the eggs are near the ground (0.5 m).

A stunning bird in both colour and demeanour, they really do have a regal air about them.




