Information on Emergency Relief Packages for Victorians

Emergency relief packages are available to support people who:

Are in mandatory self-isolation (because they have COVID-19, are suspected of having COVID-19 or have come into close contact with people who have COVID-19 or have recently travelled overseas) AND Who have little or no food, AND

Have no network of family and friends to support them.

Each eligible household will receive a two-week supply of essential goods. Food packages will include items such as long-life milk, pasta, cereal, canned vegetables and sugar. Personal care packages will also be distributed to eligible households and include soap, toothpaste and deodorant. Additional items may also be provided depending on the needs of the household, such as nappies or baby formula.

If this eventuates we may need assistance from volunteers living in the local area and from local Registered Class 2 food businesses. Check out our website for links to a survey where you can register your interest and details.


