#### Welcome, Wumindjika & G'day

The brilliant yellow of daffodils and wattle have become a feature over the last week or two all around our local area and a reminder that spring is well and truly on the way.

Although the Bureau of Meteorology is yet to officially declare the coming summer an El Nino one it appears that there is a 70% chance that will be the case and in the past, El Niño years have been correlated with an increased chance of drier springs.

During the El Niño phase warm waters head towards South America and trade winds are weakened. This results in less atmospheric moisture available for rain in Australia.



As we are all probably aware an El Niño event can intensify heat

waves, increase the severity of bushfires, and contribute to drought conditions. The influence of El Niño is primarily felt in eastern Australia, resulting in warmer-than-usual temperatures and reduced rainfall.

With that forecast in mind, it might be timely for HCCC readers to consider fire preparedness for the coming summer.



#### **Know Your Weeds**

#### **Great Mullein (Verbascum thapsus)**

Great Mullein is an erect, densely hairy biennial plant that grows to 2.5m tall. Its one main stem is woolly and has wings.

The leaves are grey-green, form a rosette around the stem, can be up to 50cm long and are covered with matted layers of short hairs. They are also strongly veined on the underside.

Flowering between January and March it displays yellow flowers, approx. 2.5cm in diameter, with 5 petals that cluster

on a metre long spike.

This plant readily colonises less fertile soils and dominates disturbed and overgrazed areas and can be easily spread by machinery. Control is best done between Oct - Jan by target spraying, hand weed weeding or cultivation prior to flowering.
